When: Sunday 21st December

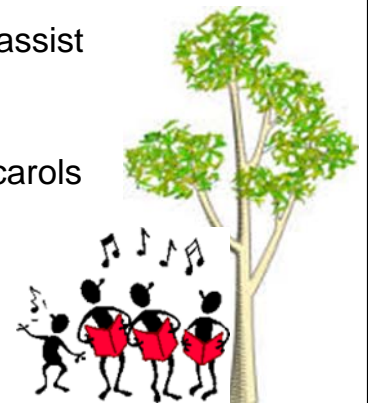
Time: 5pm until dark
