Safety is our priority

The safety of our students, staff and parents is of utmost importance at Nemingha Public School. Consequently, we are always improving our processes and practices.

Signage has been put in place on the small gate leading to and from the staff car park to highlight safety concerns with regard to the general use of the staff car park for student and parent entry to and/or exit from the school.

Parents and carers are also reminded not to not walk children in or out of the school through the staff car park. Staff sometimes leave early for a meeting or arrive late after a meeting, making the car park an unsafe place for pedestrians. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Early arrivals

Dropping students off at school before 8.50am is also a safety issue as teacher supervision of students does not commence until 8.50am. Teachers at school before 8.50am are busy in classrooms or meetings. We are happy to assist in exceptional circumstances. Please ensure you have contacted the school the day before if an earlier than 8.50am drop-off is necessary so that arrangements can be made to keep your children safe.
