Is chess an art? A science? Some claim it's both. Yet let's be honest, it's really just a game.

Just like our canteen orders, you can register to use the clothing pool section on QuickCliq. Just choose uniform order instead of meal.

Orders will close at 9am each Monday and will be filled that day. The order can be sent home with your child the next day or left at the front office for you to collect - you can add instructions on the order.

If you order after 9am it will be filled the following week.

Check out the FAQ section for instructions on how to register, set up each child, add credit and place an order.

Please note that it does take two days for credit to be loaded onto your account if you are paying via bank transfer - this is the FREE option. You can also use Paypal and credit card but these will incur a fee.

Just like lunch orders, QuickCliq charge a direct service fee of \$0.19 per order per child and all other charges will be absorbed by the P&C.
