### What fun has CAPERS been this week!

I am so proud of all the Nemingha children involved. Mrs Miller has been working for a number of weeks with the school dance troupes and they have certainly got some cool moves! I am also proud of the work the choir has put into their singing. We have over 90 children who are currently rehearsing at the TRECC in preparation for the Friday and Saturday night performances.



Experiences such as CAPERS and last year's performance "Wizard of Oz" are wonderful opportunities for our students to perform in front of an appreciative audience.

Children need to be involved in and go to the theatre as much as they can. Just as much as running about in the fresh air. They need to hear real music played by real musicians on real instruments as much as they need food and drink, and they need to read and listen to proper stories as much as they need to be loved and cared for.

Our Musica Viva program is another opportunity our children have to be involved. Under our Music "umbrella" we also provide opportunities for students to learn the guitar, piano, brass and woodwind instruments and violin at a small cost. Specialist tutors deliver these lessons. These are valuable opportunities that we consider important aspects in our

curriculum. At Nemingha we endeavour to involve our children in the creative and practical arts as much as we can.

But just let's think about the theatre for the moment.

The experiences our students are gaining from our performance this term are so important. They are not only developing their creative side by learning lines, acting and singing in front of others and developing organisational skills in back-stage work, but it contributes to their imagination as well.

The result of this imaginative joining-in is that the story becomes much more real, in a strange way. It belongs to everyone, not just the performers under the lights but the audience as well. I have been amazed with the children's enthusiasm and excitement all this week with CAPERS ... and it all works! The experience we take away is incomparably richer and fuller and more magical than it would ever have been if all we did was sit back passively and watch.

**I encourage everyone to come along to see CAPERS at the TRECC either Friday or Saturday nights, starting at 7pm. Cost for the show is \$45.90 adults, \$35.90 for pensioners and children 2-17. Family tickets, which include 2 adults and 2 children, \$28.90 each (must buy 4 tickets).**
