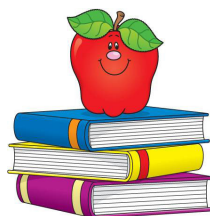

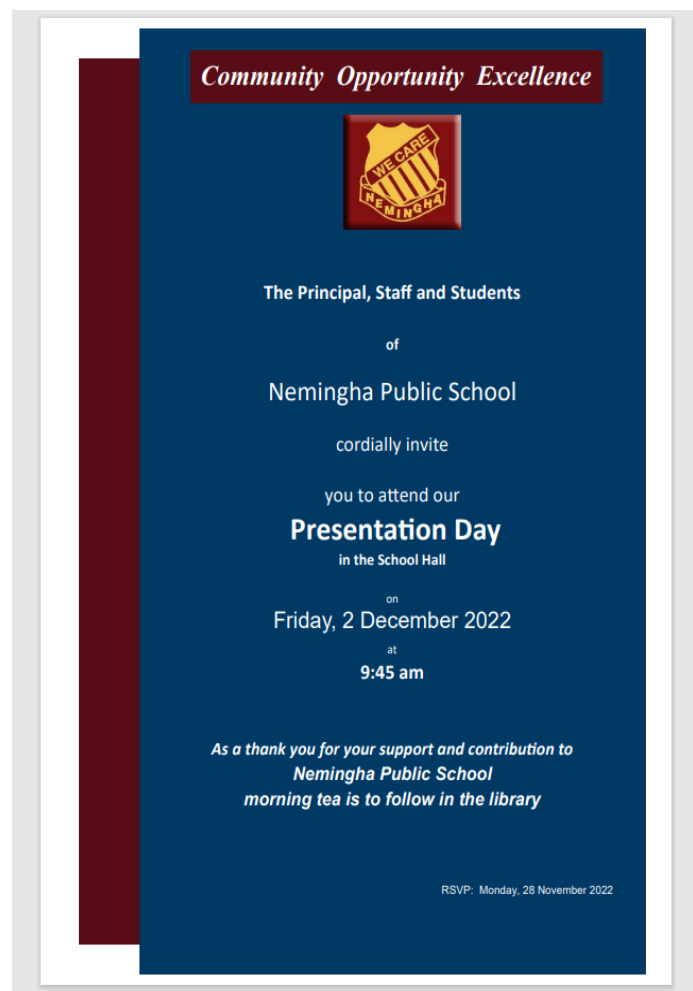
Come and join us for a celebration of learning
